Present; Ward Cllr B.Jefferson, Ward Cllr J.Whittle, Cllr S.Mars, Cllr K.Baish, Cllr J.Burton, Cllr G.Burton, Cllr S.Earle, Cllr C.Taylor, Cllr J.Warrington J.Froud (Clerk).

1. **Apologies;** None.
2. Cllr Shawn Mars called for the Resolution F4 to be implemented for the duration of the meeting, to exclude members of the Public. Proposed by Cllr Jim Warrington seconded by Cllr Janet Burton, this was agreed.
3. **Proposed Parking Restrictions for Mapleton;** Cllr Shawn Mars read out the summary of measures proposed for Mapleton parking restrictions, as discussed with Terry Weaver from Highways ERYC, at a meeting between Cllr Shawn Mars and Terry Weaver at Mapleton in December 2020.
Cllr Jim Warrington commented that it would be a good idea to extend the double yellow lines on Hatfield Lane, to a point beyond both farm entrances, and include them in the passing place. Cllr Janet Burton commented about the need for double yellow lines in front of Grey's Farm up to Sunny Dawn, as people have been parking here causing problems for vehicles entering the village from the North, with the blind brow and the sharp corner just after.
Cllr Sue Earle commented that people need somewhere to park, when visiting the village. It was thought that there is no money available to buy land for parking, at the present time.
Ward Cllr Barbara Jefferson commented that the proposal would have to go through the scrutiny committee and then public consultation, this is just the beginning. Barbara went on to say that the Parish Council should use Terry Weavers professional advice.
Ward Cllr John Whittle concurred that it was important to get on with Terry Weaver, and to tell him exactly what was needed. John went on to say if he suggests a meeting, just do it, the residents will be aware of the Parish Council rectifying a problem.
Cllr Janet Burton asked if signage could be put up at the entrances to the village reading "Mapleton Welcomes Considerate Drivers"?
The changes to the proposal were agreed, and Jim Froud will circulate the revised Plan and Summary to all Councillors before submitting to ERYC.
