

# Mapleton Parish Council Minutes of the Meeting held on the 4th of July 2023, in the Cross Keys, Cowden, by kind permission of Mr T Larkam.

Apologies: None.

Minutes May 2023 minutes were agreed as a true and correct record of what took place.

Matters Arising: Cllr Kim Baish thought that it was terrible what has been done to the roadside, outside of Mill Hill Farm, Cowden, whilst constructing the Coastal Pathway.

Ward Cllr Barbara Jefferson had managed to get the hedges that had been planted removed, they were supposed to be planted at Hollym, some miles further down the coast.

The verges have been left in a terrible state, to bring them back to the standard that James Westoby kept them in, will take a considerable amount of work.

The storage area at the junction of Garth End's Lane and the B1242 at Cowden, still needs removing, JF to contact Terry Weaver.

The Village Walk About identified re-surfacing work needed to the footpaths in Mapleton.

There is some vegetation encroaching onto the footpaths in certain places in Mapleton, this is the residents of the properties responsibility.

The hedge outside of the Council Houses in Mapleton needs cutting back from the carriageway of the B1242.

This comes under housing, so the Housing Officer will need to liaise with the residents of the Council Houses.

Police Report: No one present.

Reports of Quad bikes and GPS equipment from farms have been posted on the forum.

Drugs intelligence in the area is still ongoing.

Speeding in Hornsea and the surrounding area is of a major concern, JF to report speeding issues to the Police.

Accounts for Payment: Clerk's Fees £350.00, Postage £6.00, Room Hire £18.00 this was agreed.

Kings Coronation Seat: Thoughts for the commemorative plaque for the bench were discussed.

The date of the Coronation will be on, along with it being provided by Mapleton Parish Council.

Witherwick Community Wind Farm: Cllr Kim Baish reported that there had been a meeting and that £21,520.00 has been awarded to different projects in the area.

One project "Click Clever" to protect vulnerable children on the internet, was thought to be a great plan, but needs to be on a National level.

Planning: None.

The Planning Application for the Old Children's Camp has not gone to planning yet, so no decision has been made.

No other planning applications have been received, there were thoughts of potential applications being submitted, but this has to be treat as pure speculation at this point in time.

Village Hall: Cllr Janet Burton reported that no progress has been made..

**Willow Garth:** Reports of residents sat on the roadside, and the Bus Stop at Rolston drinking alcohol, JF to write to Willow Garth.

**Paristioners Questions:** There was a residents car damaged in Mapleton at the weekend, which was reported on Facebook as being a Parish Council matter. This is not a Parish Council matter it has to be reported to the Police.

There has been some work going on near to Grey's Farm Mapleton, thought to be pumping out a drainage blockage, due to a collapsed drain. Concerns were raised, as it was thought that it could be something to do with the connection of the Seaview drainage into the system.

**AOB:** Cllr Shawn Mars reported that Mr Tyrone Larkam has let the Parish Council use the Cross Keys as a venue for meetings, free of charge. JF to write to thank Mr Larkham.

Cllr Janet Burton reported the foul smell of the ditch at Rolston Bends, JF to report.

Cllr Shawn Mars reported the ongoing problems with the sapling trees encroaching onto the carriageway down Withernwick Road, Cowden, it was not known if Terry Weaver had given permission for volunteers to remove them
